THURSDAY, Day 1

Leave LOS ANGELES by Asiana Airlines OZ #203 at 12:20 AM

FRIDAY, Day 2 – SEOUL

Arrive Seoul at 5:20 AM

Afternoon Korea Folk Village Tour

SATURDAY, Day 3 – SEOUL – B

Morning city tour to see the major highlights of Seoul The tour will take you to the Kyongbok palace, the main imperial residence during the 600 years of the Chosun Dynasty. Afterward, visit the National Folk Museum of Korea, which preserves and exhibits the legacies of Korean culture and history. Proceed to the South Gate Open Market.

In the evening attend the world famous DPRK National Circus Performance. You will see a performance of artistic songs and dance ensembles.

WEDNESDAY, Day 7 – PYONGYANG – B,L,D

Pyongyang was the capital of Koguryo, the first feudal state of Korea, with a long history of over 1,500 years. Now, it is the capital of DPRK and the political, economic and cultural center of the country. Also, it has over 70 large parks and recreation grounds. Hence, Pyongyang is called "the city in a park". Since the Fatherland Liberation War of the Korean people (1950 – 1953) Pyongyang has taken on the look of a new city with the erection of great monumental edifices, monumental towers, museums, cultural and art establishments. Broad streets, grand buildings and parks covered with green foliage – all this gives Pyongyang the appearance of a modern city.

Full day Pyongyang tour: Enjoy a ride in the Metro, which covers all major areas of the capital city. Our first stop will be in Mangyongdae, where President Kim Il Sung was born and spend his childhood. His humble native home is preserved as it was. Continue to Mangyong Hill, which is the most elevated spot in the area. Proceed to see the Arch of Triumph and visit the Fatherland Liberation War Museum.

Evening attend Arirang Festival.

THURSDAY, Day 8 – PYONGYANG – B,L,D

Full day tour to visit to the Sonjuk Bridge, Koryo Songyumkwan Museum, and Panmunjom, where you enjoy lunch in Panmunjomkwan Restaurant. On your return to Pyongyang by bus, including a visit to the Mangyongdae Schoolchildren's Palace, which is one of the most famous modern buildings in DPRK.

FRIDAY, Day 9 – PYONGYANG – B,L,D

Day trip to Myohyang Mountains.

SATURDAY, Day 10 – B

Leave PYONGYANG by air in the morning, via Beijing

Arrive LOS ANGELES at noon
